DAY 1 WEDNESDAY MAY 15 ARRIVAL ZURICH – LUCERNE (D): Welcome in Zurich! Upon arrival at the airport meet and greet with your local guide and Proceed to half day city tour of Zurich and see the Bahnhofstrasse, Limmatquai, the Rathaus, Zurich Lake and the Old Guildhalls then proceed to Lucerne for hotel check. Overnight in your hotel in Lucerne.

DAY 2 THURSDAY MAY 16 LUCERNE – MT. TITLIS – LUCERNE (BD): Breakfast at your hotel. Enjoy an amazing journey to the lovely city of Lucerne and enjoy a full day guided city tour & Mt. Titlis. Dinner and overnight in Lucerne.

DAY 3 FRIDAY MAY 17 LUCERNE – INNSBRUCK – SALZBURG (BD): Breakfast inside the hotel. On your way to Innsbruck, have a stop a Einsiedeln, where you will have a short stop to visit Benedict Abbey. Tour of Innsbruck including Swarovski shop and have some time to spend on leisure for lunch. Transfer to Salzburg. Dinner and overnight in Salzburg.

DAY 4 SATURDAY MAY 18 SALZBURG (BD): Breakfast at your hotel. After breakfast, enjoy full day Salzburg & Sound of Music tour of Salzburg. A wonderful ride with breathtaking views of the landscape where the opening scenes were filmed. Relax and listen to the original Sound of Music soundtrack. DAY 7 TUESDAY MAY 21 BLEED – BUDAPEST (BD): Breakfast at your hotel. After breakfast, leave for the Budapest via Graz. Dinner and overnight in Budapest

DAY 8 WEDNESDAY MAY 22 BUDAPEST (BD): Breakfast at your hotel. After breakfast, meet your local guide and enjoy sightseeing of the most cosmopolitan metropolis of Eastern Europe. Drive in to Buda and Pest, the twin towns of the Hungarian capital linked by many spectacular bridges across Danube. See the Citadel on Mount Gellert, the ornate Parliament and visit Hero Square. From the Fisherman's Bastion, enjoy a panoramic view of the sprawling city, home to more than 1/5 of the Hungarian population. Admire the 14th century Matthias Coronation Church. DAY 9 THURSDAY MAY 23 BUDAPEST – VIENNA (BD): Breakfast at your hotel. After breakfast, drive to Vienna, once the centre of the might Hapsburg Empire. Upon arrival, check in at your hotel. Remainder of the day to be spend on leisure. Dinner and overnight in Vienna.

Start the day with a visit to the splendid Schonbrunn Palace and its manicured gardens. Drive along the Ring Boulevard, pass the State Opera House and stop at the famous Heldenplatz for a picture of Hofburg Palace, winter residence of the Austrian royal family. During the walking tour of the old town, visit the impressive St. Stephen Cathedral. In the afternoon, board your coach to the Designer Outlet of Parndorf. Here you can shop for all famous brands with discounts up to 60% year round. End of the day transfer back to Vienna. Dinner and overnight in Vienna.

DAY 11 SATURDAY MAY 25 VIENNA – KRAKOW (BD): Breakfast at your hotel. After breakfast, drive to Poland and arrive in Krakow, cultural capital of Poland where Pope John Paul II served as archbishop. Tonight enjoy a folkloric dinner held in a traditional restaurant with Polish polka dances.

DAY 12 SUNDAY MAY 26 KRAKOW (BD): Breakfast at your hotel. After breakfast, meet your local guide and enjoy a half day guided tour of Krakow. Ascend Wawel Hill to visit Krakow Cathedral– burial place of Polish Heroes and View Wawel Castle, former residence of Polish Kings. In the old Krakow, visit the medieval town square (where today the 12th century Cloth Hall houses and arcade of folk art shops). Good shopping here, there's the 14th century St. Mary Church, famous for its baroque altar and life size Marian Images. You're in a special treat! A prayer devotion in honor of the Divine Mercy at its world famed shine at 3:00pm. There is the Convent Chapel of Saint Faustina to whom Christ had apparitions to propagate the Divine Mercy Movement; "Jesus, I trust in You" has worked wonders to millions since then. Most inspiring briefing. Now an impressive basilica has been built. Dinner and overnight in Krakow.

DAY 13 MONDAY MAY 27 KRAKOW – WADOWICE – CZESTOCHOWA (BD): Breakfast at your hotel. After breakfast, bring a visit to the Wieliczka Salt Mines a unique attraction underground of cave chambers, grotto, chapel and sculptures all made of salt. It was declared a World Heritage Site by UNESCO. Pass by Wadowice and realize how Poland has contributed a Polish Pope. Visit his house, now a museum containing mementos of the beloved Pope. Also the church where he began his priesthood. Continue to Czestochowa for an unforgettable Eucharistic Celebration at the magnificent 14th century Paulite monastery at Jasna Gora. Venerate the very miraculous Black Madonna, by elegant thought to be painted by St. Luke. This has become a world famous pilgrimage centre and the most important in Poland. See the chapels and museum where gifts from the high and mighty offered to the Blessed Mother will simply overwhelmed you. End of the day check in at your hotel. Dinner and overnight in Czestochowa.

DAY 14 TUESDAY MAY 28 CZESTOCHOWA – PRAGUE (BD): Breakfast at your hotel. After breakfast, drive to Wroclaw and continue to Prague, the Golden City and the ancient capital of Bohemia and now of the Czech Republic. Dinner and overnight in Prague.

DAY 15 WEDNESDAY MAY 29 PRAGUE (BD): Breakfast at your hotel. After breakfast, meet your local guide for a full day guided tour. Sightseeing of this city spires, one of the loveliest preserved cities in Europe.
